If you are a K-12 student in Georgia, you can enter the Georgia Latino Complete Count Committee "Si te Cuentan, Tu Cuentas!" Contest!

To enter you must follow the theme "How will the 2010 Census reflect the growing diversity in your community? Why is the Census important?" and...

Grades K-5: Submit a drawing on 8.5" x 11" paper*

Grades 6-8: Submit a Photo Essay. Limit is one photo and accompanying essay must be between 250 to 500 words.*

Grades 9-12 & Adult: Submit either an essay OR a link to their YouTube video. Essay must be between 500 to 750 words. OR the video must be between 30 seconds to 3 minutes and posted on YouTube.*

Submissions will be posted on www.latino2010.org. Submissions will be judged by voters on www.latino2010.org and by GLCCC judges. 3 Winners from each division (K-5, 6-8, 9-12, & Adult) will be eligible for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place prizes and recognized at a reception on March 20th, 2010!

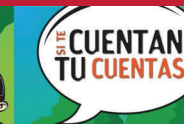

"Si te Cuentan, Tu Cuentas!" Contest



Theme: How will the 2010 Census reflect the growing diversity in your communities? Why is the Census important?

OFFICIAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. To enter you must be an elementary, middle, or high school student (or Georgia resident, if participating in Adult Division) attending school in the state of Georgia. This contest is open to all students attending school in Georgia regardless of race or ethnicity. The contest is being conducted by the Georgia Latino Complete Count Committee (GLCCC) and is geared to raise awareness within the Latino community. However, the contest is open to all students. All entrants who are under the age of eighteen (18) at the time of the entry must have the permission of at least one (1) of their parents and/or legal guardians to enter. By entering the Contest, entrants and/or their parents or legal guardians (if such entrants are minors): (i) agree to accept and be bound by all terms of these Official Rules and Regulations ("Official Rules"), and (ii) agree that the GLCCC Chair has total autonomy over any disputes or issues arising from or relating to the Contest.
2. To be eligible all entrants must provide the "**Entry Form: Parental Consent/Media Release for Student Participation**" by mail to: GLCCC Contest, P. O. Box 29506, Atlanta, Georgia 30359 OR fax to (404) 759-2671. The "**Entry Form: Parental Consent/Media Release for Student Participation**" must be fully completed and postmarked no later than February 19, 2010 or faxed by 5:00PM on February 19, 2010.
3. Eligible entries must follow the theme and meet the following criteria:
 - a) Grades K-5: Entrants must submit **a drawing** on 8.5" x 11" paper. All submissions must be sent by mail to: GLCCC Contest, P. O. Box 29506, Atlanta, Georgia 30359 by February 19, 2010. The "**Entry Form: Parental Consent/Media Release for Student Participation**" must accompany the entry. All eligible entries will be posted on latino2010.org
 - b) Grades 6-8: Entrants must submit **a Photo Essay** to contest@latino2010.org by February 19, 2010. The "**Entry Form: Parental Consent/Media Release for Student Participation**" must be received by mail or fax before submissions are posted on latino2010.org. Each submission is limited to one photo (jpeg file) and the essay accompanying the photo must be sent as a Microsoft Word file and should be between 250 to 500 words.
 - c) Grades 9-12 & Adult: Entrants may submit either **an essay** OR **a link to their YouTube video** to contest@latino2010.org by February 19, 2010. The "**Entry Form: Parental Consent/Media Release for Student Participation**" or "**Entry/Media Release Form**" (for Adult Division) must be received by mail before submissions are posted on latino2010.org. Essays must be submitted as a Microsoft Word file and should be between 500 to 750 words. OR the video must be between 30 seconds to 3 minutes and posted on YouTube.
 - d) All entries must include name, county, and school and grade (if applicable).**
- *Please note that entries may be in Spanish or English.
4. All eligible entries received by the dates specified will be judged by voters on latino2010.org and by official GLCCC judges. Official GLCCC judges will judge based upon the following criteria: clarity of thought, creativity, practicality, potential to raise awareness about the 2010 Census and potential to draw attention to the diverse communities in Georgia. **Please visit latino2010.org for full details on rating criteria.** The decisions of the judges will then be combined with a scoring based upon votes on the latino2010.org website and the final score will be binding on all participants. The last day for online voting will be March 5, 2010 by 5:00PM.
5. The winner will be notified by the GLCCC at the telephone number or email address provided on his/her Official Entry Form. Winners must also meet all eligibility requirements, including the execution and return of all necessary releases.
6. If a student wins from outside the metro Atlanta area (over 50 miles of travel one-way), a travel stipend of \$100 will be provided to the parent(s) to cover transportation costs for attending the reception in Atlanta. The reception will be March 20, 2010. Winners will be notified of time and location.
7. Prizes will be posted on latino2010.org. Check the website frequently for updates!
